The FAI International gliding commission are pleased to announce the schedule for the 10th series of National FAI Sailplane Grand Prix events.

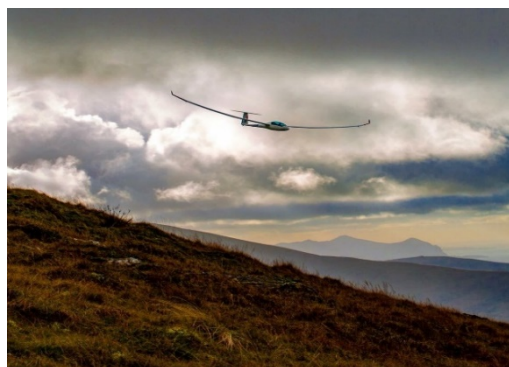
The 10th series will commence after the final of the 9th series at La Cerdanya in Spain during June 2019. <http://www.sgp.aero/finals2019>

The 10th series National event schedule include 3 exciting new venues for SGP racing. The first and only event in 2019 is to be held at **Livno** in Bosnia Herzegovina not only a new venue for SGP racing but the first time for any International gliding event in Bosnia Herzegovina. The club at Livno offers an opportunity to fly in this beautiful region between Split and Sarajevo. The soaring area is known locally as "little Namibia" reflecting the excellent soaring conditions. The National FAI/SGP event in Great Britain will be held at **Denbigh** in North Wales. This is a relatively unknown region for sailplane racing pilots but has been extensively explored in recent years with some remarkable flights being completed. The region includes the Snowdon the highest mountain in Wales and some spectacular scenery in the Snowdon national park. The possibility to fly in ridge and wave lift will make this a very interesting contest.

The 2020 French FAI/SGP national contest will be held at **Rion de lands** situated in south west France. This region benefits from it's southerly latitude with good early spring conditions possible. <http://planeurspaysadour.net>

The two southern hemisphere National FAI/SGP events will be held at sites which have considerable experience both having hosted an FAI/SGP final in recent years. **Potchefstroom** in South Africa offering great flatland racing and **Viticura** in Chile with spectacular conditions and scenery. Returning for another year are **Varese** in the pre-alps region of Northern Italy, **Cerdanya** in the Spanish eastern Pyrenees and **Boras** in Sweden. Entry will be open at least 6 months before each event and the FAI/SGP event web sites will be available from early 2019
